In addition the Japanese had 100 small mine layers, each with one or two small guns. They also had 27 auxiliary cruisers, converted merchant-steamers, with displacements ranging from 4,500 to 7,500 tons and speeds of about 17 knots. These were armed with 2-76mm guns, 2-57mm guns and four 47mm guns each.

There were also three auxiliary gunboats of 600 tons displacement, capable of speeds of 10 knots, that were armed with 2-76mm guns and four smaller guns.

There were also two hospital ships, launched in 1900, displacing 2,600 tons and having speeds of 13.5 knots.
